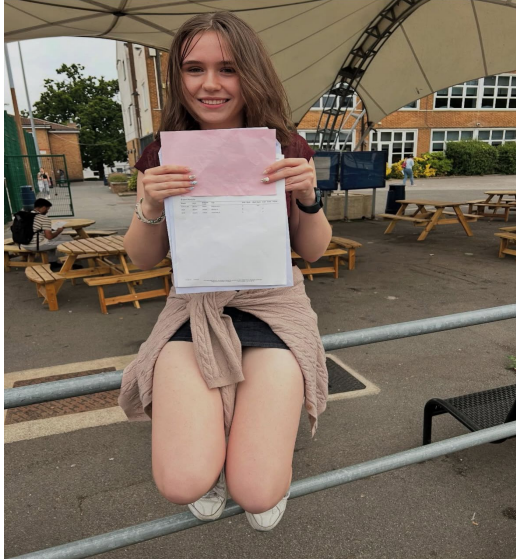

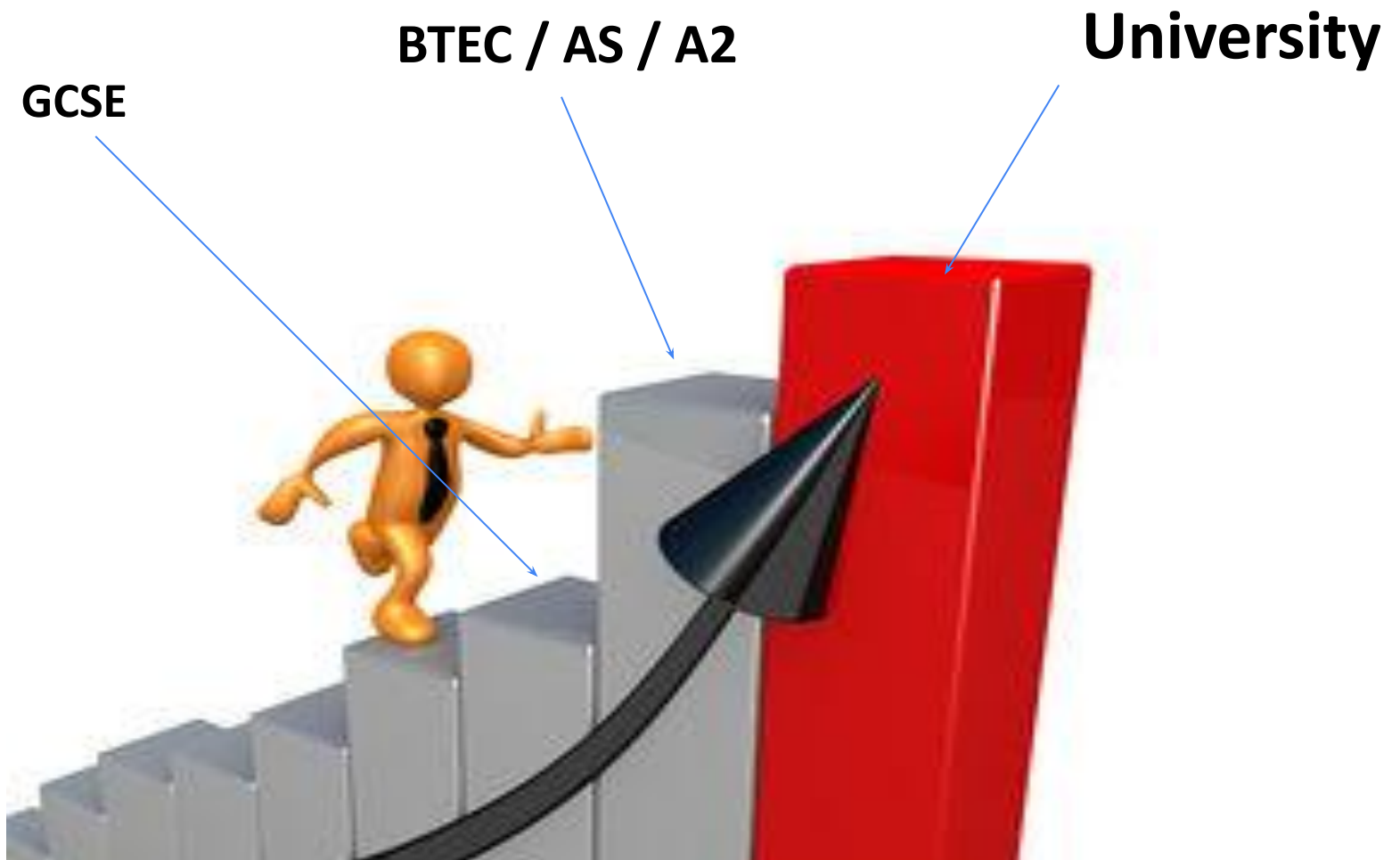

Effort- 1 hour private study for every hour in the classroom

Organisation- at least one folder for each subject

Independent study

Enrichment – Wednesday afternoons

Utilising free periods – help plan the weeks free lessons with your child

Expectations

- 18 months! Work hard from the start
- Students must attend their tutorial time each week - will go through important issues during these sessions
