



The Hollyfield uniform is a key part of our school ethos and identity. Our aim is that it is practical, affordable, easily maintained and worn with pride. Students should be dressed smartly and comfortably, so they are ready to learn. Every student is expected to meet our high standards of dress and to take pride in their appearance.

School uniform is compulsory for all students except the Sixth Form. Students who arrive at school in the incorrect uniform will be sent home and receive a sanction.

Items requiring the Hollyfield logo can be purchased from School Zone in Bantalls, Kingston or on-line.

The PTA have limited supplies of school uniform to support families with financial difficulties, if this applies to you please contact the school office. They also have regular sales of good quality, used uniform items which are advertised in the ebulletin.

General Appearance

Coats and other outdoor clothing such as hats, gloves and scarves may be worn in cold weather, but are not to be worn inside school buildings. Scarves or other neck coverings, including snoods, should not be worn pulled up over the face at any time.

Pupils may wear two, single plain studs in each ear and a watch, but no other jewellery. They must be removed for PE. If students are considering a piercing this must be done over a summer holiday to allow the piercing to heal so it can be removed for certain activities whilst in school.

If make-up must be worn it should be minimal.

Nail varnish, false nails and false eyelashes are prohibited.

Hair should be clean and tidy. Long hair should be tied back from the face and hair bands, clips or other hair accessories should be strictly functional and conservative in style and size. If students wish to dye their hair then it is only acceptable to do so in natural shades.

Haircuts should be sensible.

No patterns should be visible in student's hair or eyebrows

Tattoos are illegal before the age of 18, even with a parent's consent so are not permitted in school.

Where legitimate reasons are given for pupils wearing incorrect uniform (i.e. damaged clothing or a medical issue) this should be supported by way of a signed note by the parent/carer for the attention of the pupil's form tutor.

Religious and Cultural Items

As a truly comprehensive school we are dedicated to supporting diversity and students are encouraged to be proud of their identity.

We are also sensitive to the needs of different cultures, races and religions and will act reasonably in accommodating these needs, subject to health and safety considerations. We request that any religious headwear should be black in colour, of a reasonable length and secured safely.

Sixth Form uniform

At Hollyfield we have a relaxed dress code as we want to treat our students as young adults. We make sure that the clothes that our students wear should be appropriate for a school environment.

General rules

- Students must not wear logos which may cause any offence.
- No micro/mini skirts.
- No low cut tops or tops which expose the midriff.
- No jeans or trousers that are excessively ragged, torn or ripped.
- No displays of underwear of any kind, including the result of low cut jeans or trousers. A belt should be worn if necessary.
- No hats or hoods are to be worn inside school buildings
- Students must wear their ID badge at all times.
